
## Parking and alternative ways of getting to Gowrie


- We do not have on site car parking
- Please do not park in local business carparks, and in particular Foodland do not allow car parking for anyone other than customers.
- Street parking signage is varied in the surrounding streets and the map below shows where you can park. There are breaks in the course to allow you to move your car



## **Public transport**

You can park at the Entertainment Centre Park and Ride car park for \$4.00 (between 5am – 6.30pm) and catch the tram.

Thebarton tram stop is on Port Road with a 5 minute walk down Light Terrace to the centre on Dew Street. The tram is free for any journey between South Terrace and the Entertainment Centre.



Buses: Port Road (stop 2: 150, 115, 117, 118, 286, 287, 288), and George Street (stop 3, B10)

## **Cycling or walking**

If you want to ride your bicycle and you're not sure of a safe, fast route you can use the Cycle Instead route planner at the below link. It will give you the best route from your starting point to the office, how long it will take (at 20km/h) and the exact distance. It even tells you how many kilojoules you will burn on the cycle and how much cO2 you will be saving!
