## Benefits of enrolling in our Universal Access Program for your child's kindergarten year:

- We offer flexible sessions throughout the week combining kindergarten with long day care to meet the care needs of your family.
- We adhere to the same curriculum requirements and quality standards as a stand-alone Department for Education kindergarten, including the provision of a qualified Early Childhood Teacher to plan and deliver each kindergarten session.
- Staying here for kindergarten reduces the number of transitions prior to school, supporting the continuity of both learning and wellbeing for your child.

 Your child will be extending their learning in a familiar environment where they have established relationships with staff and peers.

You and your child can continue your routine of attending long day care with siblings, reducing the need for additional pickups and dropoffs.

 Summative reports will be provided at the end of the kindergarten year to support your child's transition to school.
